Danville Host – The Club had a free meals program at Moffet Church on Saturday, January 2, 2021. 200 meals were prepared and distributed at Moffett. A carry out lunch consisting of ham or turkey sandwich, chips, and cookies was served.

Hampton Mercury - Club collects used eyeglasses at various collection sites throughout Hampton, VA and turns in the eyeglasses for recycling at the Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center of Southeastern Virginia. Turned in 205 eyeglasses.

James City - Picking up used eyeglasses from MyEyeDr and delivering for recycling. Meeting the goal of providing vision assistance to needy individuals in the community.

Processing hearing aid referrals for needy people. Meeting the goal of providing hearing aid assistance to needy hearing-impaired individuals in the community.

Designing and preparing face masks to donate for people to use during the COVID-19 pandemic. Addressing the goal of providing help to members of the community.

Collecting & delivering plastic bags for recycling into Trex benches for an elementary school. Addressing the goal of supporting environmental goals and needs within the community.

Providing rides to and from the parking lot at Sentara Hospital for those needing assistance. Addressing the goal of supporting individuals in the community.

Assisting with processing of food for a program that encourages the community to donate nutritious food to the needy. Addressing the goal of providing relief for food insecurity in the community.

Volunteering at Literacy for Life program that prepares students (adults whose first language is not English or whose English skills require development) for GED or citizenship test by teaching classes in geography, history, government, economics, & English skills via Zoom. Addressing the goal of supporting needs of the community.

Printed and delivered consent forms in preparation for SPOT Vision Screening on February 8.

Collecting trash & debris along Marclay Drive. Contributing to the maintenance of a litter-free community.

Walking 52 charity miles dedicated to "Sight for Kids." Meeting the goal of providing vision assistance to needy individuals in the community.

Newport News Warwick - A food service event that directly provides nutritious foods to hungry community members at Temple Baptist Church. The club provided 6 pair of eyeglasses to needy individuals.

An ongoing monthly support group for adults who are living with blindness and/or visual impairment that fosters personal growth, self-determination, peer-to-peer engagement, emotional support, independence and mobility. Cost of \$145.00.

Norfolk Ocean View - Power Red Blood Donation. Drove to Chesapeake to pick up eyeglasses to recycle.

One of our Lions supported the local Boy Scout Troop with administrative volunteer work and counseling for scouts.

One of our Lions provided daily caretaking for an elderly neighbor.

Onancock - Donated 45 pairs of sweatsuits to Metompkin Elementary School, a low-income school, values at \$500.00.

The club recycled and repurposed items, 10 Items, 6 Volunteers, 6 Hours.

Collecting & delivering plastic bags for recycling into Trex benches for an elementary school. Addressing the goal of supporting environmental goals and needs within the community.

Powhatan - Collected food from grocery stores and assisted other volunteers with stocking the Powhatan Food Pantry.
