



Lions of Virginia Disaster Support



Residents affected by the recent floods have been advised by Emergency Management agencies to not wait to begin clean-up. They are in need of cleaning supplies. Lions and their Lions Clubs can help!

Please follow the instructions to assemble Flood Buckets as shown or consider a donation of \$75 per bucket to supply the funds for purchase:

Bucket Contents:

- **One five-gallon round bucket with re-sealable lid** (14.35" h x 12.19" w x 12.19" d)
 - No screw lids; May be used, but must be free from all residual products
 - Advertisements on the outside acceptable (Lions logos recommended!)
- **One 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent**
- **One 16-40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner** - No spray cleaners
- **One 16-34 oz. bottle dish soap**
- **One 4-8 oz. pump spray air freshener (liquid, not gel)**
- **One 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellent (pack of 10-20 wipes also acceptable)**
 - Pump spray bottles must have protective covers
- **One scrub brush** - With or without handle
- **18 re-useable cleaning wipes** - No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels
 - Remove from packaging
- **Five scouring pads** - No stainless-steel pads with soap in them
 - Remove from packaging
- **36-50 clothespins**
- **One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)**
- **24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45-gallon sizes)**
 - Remove from packaging
- **Five N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1-3 mm thickness)** - No surgical masks
- **Two pairs kitchen gloves** - Durable for multiple uses
 - Remove from packaging
- **One pair work gloves** - Cotton with leather palm or all leather

Assembly:

Place all large bottles/items upright in the bottom of the bucket. Balance with soft items rolled or folded to conserve space. Place the folded trash bags in the top and secure the cover.

Notes:

- Sponges have been removed from the list of supplies due to the challenge of locating the non-cellulose sponges that prevent mildew. Non-cellulose sponges will be added to each bucket upon arrival at the affiliate warehouse. Please include \$3/bucket to cover the cost of the sponges plus shipping.
- Do not include any personal notes, money or additional material in the kits.
- Contents of kits or the containers of kits should not be imprinted with cartoon characters, advertisements, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols.

Transport:

Stack securely to prevent load shifting in transport vehicle. Flood bucket donations may be delivered to the following locations (water & cleaning supplies only):

Hygiene Kit Contents & Assembly:**One hand towel** (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches)

- No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels

One washcloth

- No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels

One comb

- Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
- No pocket combs or picks
- Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth

One toenail or fingernail clipper

- No emery boards or metal nail files

Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger)

- No Ivory or Jergen's soap
- Do not remove from packaging

One adult toothbrush

- Do not remove from packaging
- Personal advertising not acceptable

10 adhesive bandages ($\frac{3}{4}$ by 3 inches)

- Common household bandages acceptable

One one-gallon size re-sealable bag**Assembly Instructions**

- Lay hand towel flat on a table.
- Lay the washcloth in the center of the hand towel.
- Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth (except the plastic bag).
- Fold the sides of the hand towel to cover the items.
- Grasp the bundle tightly and roll over the remainder of the towel.
- Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag, remove air, and seal.

Notes

- **All items must be new.**
- **Do not wash any of the items** as they will no longer be considered new.
- Do not include any personal notes, money or additional materials in the kits.
- Contents of kits or the containers of kits should not be imprinted with cartoon characters, advertisements, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols.

Transport Instructions

- Neatly pack filled Ziploc bags into plastic totes for ease of transport.
- Stack securely inside transport to prevent shifting in transit
