The Camp is sponsored by the Lions Clubs of District 24I, and the Lions Charity Foundation of Southeastern Virginia. Lions members along with volunteer medical assistance from Children's Hospital of the Kings Daughter, Portsmouth Naval Hospital, Virginia Beach General Hospital and other local medical facilities, participate at camp. We also partner with staff and students from Old Dominion University to provide administrative assistance and trained Counselors. The experiences from our camping program will benefit campers for years to come.

Lion's Diabetes Family Camp Program is dedicated to:

- Provide a safe and stimulating learning experience for campers.
- Teach children and teens how to manage their diabetes while maintaining an active lifestyle.
- Provide the opportunity to meet other kids with diabetes for friendship and peer support.
- Promote self-confidence and independence, which is needed to deal with the challenges of diabetes.

The camp's medical staff includes physicians, registered nurses, registered dietitians, certified diabetes educators, aerobic instructors, and exercise physiologists. These diabetes specialists help campers to learn how to manage their diabetes while away from home. Camp Food service staff, activities directors, pharmacists, podiatrists, ophthalmologists, art instructors, aerobic instructors, and councilors complete the staff. Each staff member is dedicated to making camp a safe and fun filled learning experience.

The Lions Diabetes Family Camp is the largest Service Project in District 24I, and we need your continued financial support. Thousands of children with diabetes have participated in the Lions Family diabetes Camp over the years. It is the only camp of its kind for children and teens with diabetes located in Tidewater Virginia area.

The cost per camper is approximately **\$250.00**, which includes all meals, snacks, activities, heated cabin with bunk beds for sleeping quarters.
